CHURCH REPAIRS. The vestry hopes that you are  
appreciating all the work that has taken place to get us  
safely back into church. As you can imagine, this has  
come at a high cost, & it is only right you should see how  
the money has been spent. £4,771.20 was the costs for  
the ceiling repair. £11,219.30 for the dry rot, re-  
plastering & painting etc. Work needed on the central  
heating including the safety inspection certificate  
£1,849.94 Added to these costs was work done on the  
water leak at the Rectory which came to £922.88 Making  
a total spend recently of £18,763.32 To cover these costs  
we have had to sell some of our diminishing stock of  
shares. If anyone feels that they could donate any amount  
towards these cost it would be much appreciated.

BISHOP'S LENT APPEAL. Thank you to all who donated
